



Lay Eucharistic Visitor Training and Lay Eucharistic Minister Training,

The eucharist (or communion) is an important part of worship for Episcopalians. There are two ways lay people (members who are not a part of the clergy) may serve as Eucharistic Ministers at St. Andrew's Episcopal Church.

1. **Lay Eucharistic Visitor:** Some members of our parish desire communion but cannot come to worship due to illness or other challenges. In order to serve their needs, our Lay Eucharistic Visitors bring communion directly to them — whether they are at home or in the hospital.
2. **Lay Eucharistic Minister:** A Lay Eucharistic Minister serves the chalice (the chalice holds the wine) during worship on communion Sundays.
